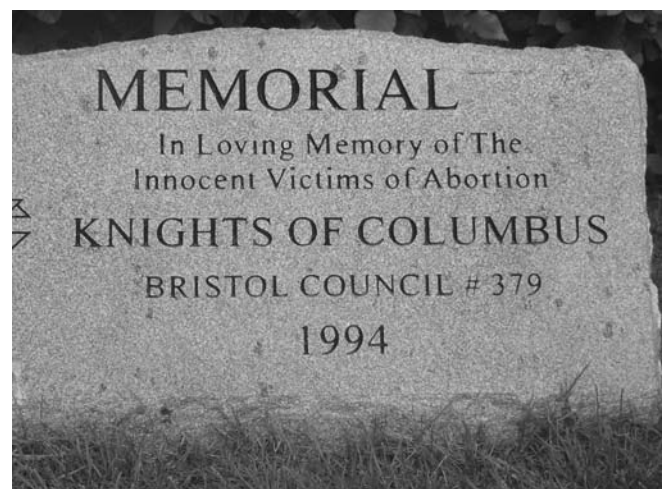


*"Then Judas, which had betrayed Him, saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests . . . and they took counsel, and bought with them the potters' field to bury strangers in."*

This excerpt from the Gospel of St. Matthew is probably the origin of the name Potter's Field; certainly, even in pre-Biblical times, man felt the obligation to do justice and honor to the dead with proper burial. The original Potters Field is thought to have been located in Hinnom valley Jerusalem. The burial ground was also called the "Field of Blood" "Aceldama" in the Aramaic language.

When our cemetery was consecrated on August 17<sup>th</sup> 1884 the responsibility of laying to rest the bodies of those who died indigent or unbefriended was continued with the establishment of our own Potters field at the southwest corner of the lot where a fenced in area is located. Many generations ago this was also where stillborn babies were also laid to rest.

When our local Knights of Columbus vacated their home on Metacom Avenue a place was needed for a 1994-monument marker dedicated to the innocent victims of abortion, as well as a statue given in 1995 in memory of Mr. and Mrs. Manuel Sardinha by their family. We thought it appropriate that they be placed in our cemetery. When visiting the cemetery, please stop by and say a prayer for all those interred on our Potters Field.
