Every Tuesday night during Lent we will have a Communion Service at 7:00 PM.

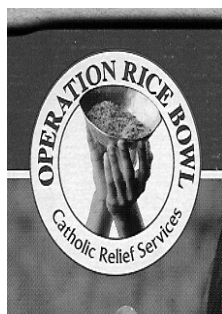
Every Thursday night during Lent we will have the Stations of the Cross at 7:00 PM and end with Benediction.
